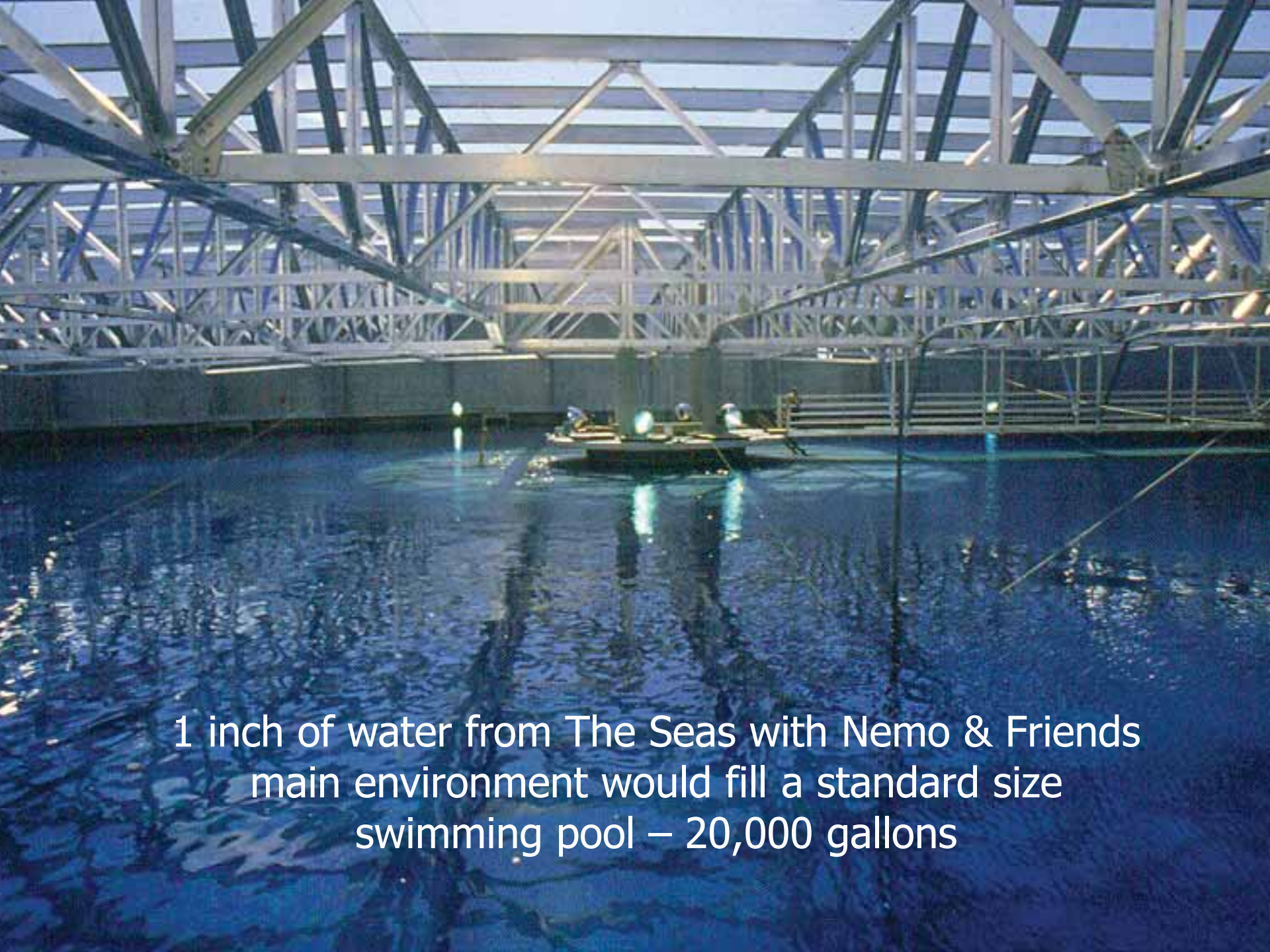
- 5.7 million gallons in the main environment

The Seas with Nemo & Friends main environment measures 203 feet in diameter and is 27 feet deep.



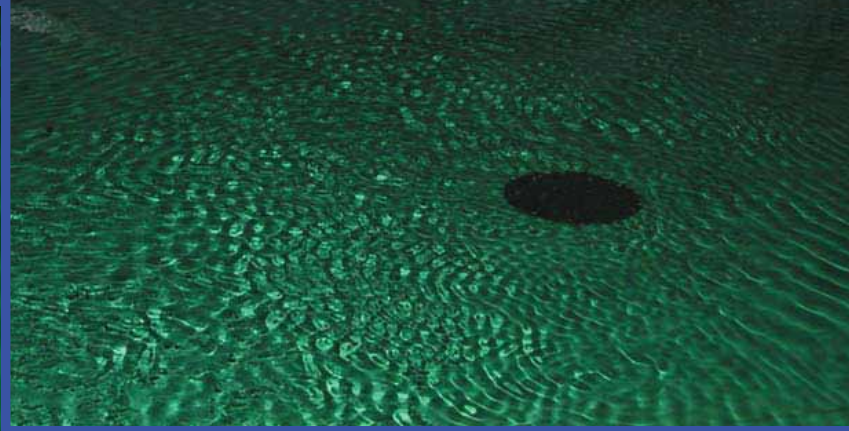
The main environment is so large that Spaceship Earth (160 feet in diameter) would fit inside with room to spare



1 inch of water from The Seas with Nemo & Friends
main environment would fill a standard size
swimming pool – 20,000 gallons



- Water turnover every three hours



- Two closed loop isolation tanks – 100,000 gallons and 40,000 gallons



- Automated control system with Opto 22 Technology



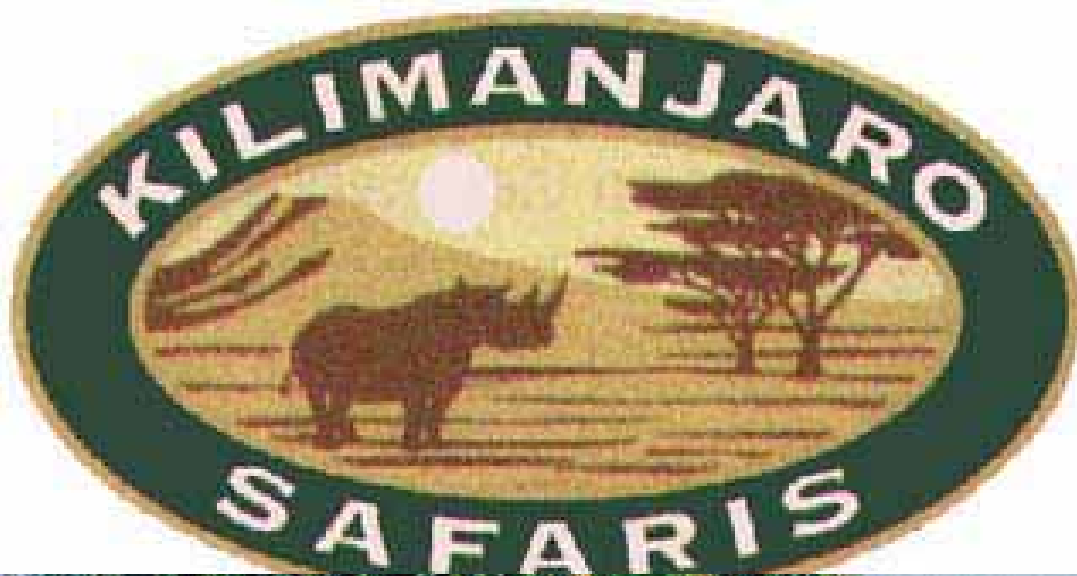

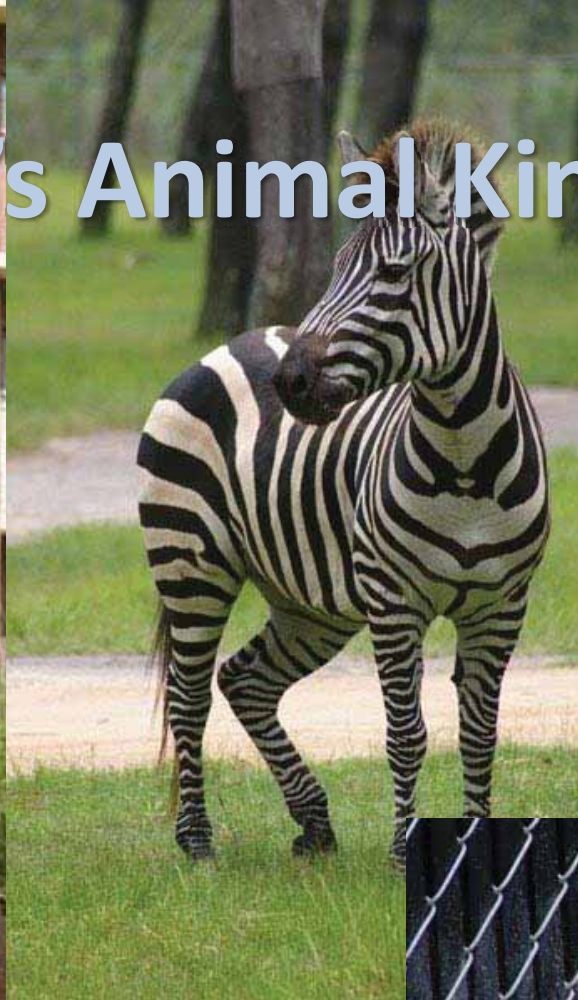
